

READMISSION

A **READMISSION** student is defined as a student who has attended OSU but was not enrolled during the immediate past semester (except the summer session). A readmission student must file an updated Application for Admission and submit an application fee. A student who has enrolled at another college or university since last attending OSU must submit a transcript from each school. Admission status will be determined after an evaluation of the previous work has been made. Minimum GPA requirements are listed below.

ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS

- **Hours:** All references to “hours” in the chart below refer to college-level semester credit hours and exclude remedial and leisure activity courses.
- **GPA:** All references to “GPA” refer to retention/graduation grade point average, as calculated by OSU admissions personnel, using all college work attempted.

In addition to the requirements listed above, applicants admitted to the university based on the retention standards also need to be aware that several undergraduate colleges have higher GPA standards for entry into certain departments and/or enrollment in upper division courses. Please check with the individual departments for specific requirements.

APPLICATION TIPS

- ◆ **Apply early:** Early application gives the Admission’s staff more time to work with you if you do not currently meet admission requirements.
- ◆ **Complete Application:** It is very important that you complete all questions on the Application for Admission. Failure to do so delays processing time.
