

TRANSFER

A transfer student is one who has earned a minimum of 7 semester hours of college-level credit after graduation from high school. If you have earned less than 7 hours please refer to the admission requirements for freshmen.

Documents Required

1. Undergraduate Application for Admission/Scholarship and \$40 non-refundable application fee.
2. Official transcript (dated less than one year old) from *each* college or university attended.
3. Official high school transcript containing your class rank, grade point average, ACT or SAT scores, and graduation date if you have less than 24 college-level credit hours.

ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS

- **Hours:** All references to “hours” in the chart below refer to college-level semester credit hours and exclude remedial and leisure activity courses.
- **GPA:** All references to “GPA” refer to retention/graduation grade point average, as calculated by OSU admissions personnel, using all college work attempted.

Note: Certain engineering programs require a 2.70 overall grade point average for nonresidents applicants, regardless of hours earned.

Credit Hours Attempted	Requirements
7-23	Meet Freshman Admission requirements & 2.25 GPA
24-59	2.25 GPA
60+ hours or associate degree	2.0 GPA

English Proficiency Requirement:

All new applicants for undergraduate study for whom English is a second language are required to demonstrate English proficiency through one of the following testing options:

1. Test of English as Foreign Language (TOEFL) score ≥ 500 (paper-based exam) or ≥ 173 (computer-based exam) *or*
2. International English Language Testing System (IELTS) score of 6.0

TRANSFER CREDIT EVALUATION

Once admitted to OSU, an evaluation of your transfer credits completed to date will normally be completed within five working days of receipt of all official transcript(s). For advisement purposes, it is important for your evaluation to be complete before you come to campus for enrollment. Please note that credit earned

TRANSFER ENROLLMENT

INTERNATIONAL TRANSFER

International applicants are admitted to OSU based on equivalent performance criteria and the nonresident retention standards, as required for US educated applicants. Evidence of adequate English proficiency and financial certification must also be received before a formal admission can be granted.
