

INTERNATIONAL READMISSION

An international, readmission student is a student that is a citizen of any country other than the U.S., is not in the U.S. or plan to enter the U.S. as an immigrant and has attended OSU but was not enrolled during the immediate past semester (except the summer session). A readmission student must submit an updated application for admission, a new Financial Guarantee and an application fee. A student who has enrolled at another college or university since last attending OSU must submit a transcript from each school. Admission status will be determined after an evaluation of the previous work has been completed. The minimum GPA requirements for admission in good standing are as follows:

All Colleges	2.00 college GPA
Engineering Majors	2.70 college GPA

In addition to the requirements listed above, applicants admitted to the university based on the retention standards also need to be aware that several undergraduate colleges have higher GPA standards for entry into certain departments and/or enrollment in upper division courses. Please check with the individual departments for specific requirements.

APPLICATION TIPS

- ◆ ***Apply early:*** Early applicant gives the International Admission staff more time to work with you if you do not currently meet admission requirements. It also gives you more time to secure a student visa and to make arrangements to arrive on campus before classes begin.
- ◆ ***Complete Application:*** : It is very important that you complete all questions on the International Application for Admission. Failure to do so delays processing time.
- ◆ ***Send everything together:*** For the quickest response from International admissions, please submit all required materials together. (Application, academic records, financial guarantee and application fees.)
