Media and Strategic Communications

(Multimedia Journalism, Sports Media, and Strategic Communications) = 2.50 GPA and 28+ credit hours

Communication Sciences and Disorders = 2.50 GPA and 15+ credit hours

Graphic Design = 2.75 GPA and 12+ credit hours

Design, Housing & Merchandising= 2.00 less than 31 hours; 2.25 for 31-45 hours; 2.50 for more than 45 hours

Human Development and Family Science= 2.00 less than 31 hours; 2.25 for 31-45 hours; 2.50 for more than 45 hours

Nutritional Sciences= 2.50

Hotel and Restaurant Administration= 2.00

Some colleges/departments require a higher GPA and credit hour combination for readmission. The GPA and credit combinations to the left will be used with the procedures outlined above.

* The cumulative retention/graduation grade point average reflects academic forgiveness. For those students receiving academic forgiveness by repeating courses or through academic reprieve or renewal, the cumulative retention/graduation grade point average is recalculated to exclude forgiven courses/semesters.
