CREDIT TRANSFER GUIDE

This guide serves as a course equivalency checklist for students transferring from INTI College to Oklahoma State University.

INFORMATION SHEET

1. The total transfer credit that may be applied to a degree program is subject to institutional and departmental policies. Refer to the Oklahoma State University (OSU) catalog for more information regarding the requirements for transfer credit and for the individual college's degree program requirements.
2. During the evaluation process, course descriptions for the courses offered at INTI College are reviewed to determine if there is an equivalent course offered at OSU. An OSU course number is assigned to the INTI course that closely matches a course offered at OSU. However, if a course description does not closely match a course offered at OSU, an elective credit (----) is assigned.
3. Code letters are used to identify courses that may be used to fulfill general education requirements. The code letters used are as follows:

GENERAL EDUCATION CODES

A = Analytical and Quantitative Thought

H = Humanities

I = International Dimension

L = Scientific Investigation

N = Natural Science

S = Social and Behavioral Sciences

4. To determine if a course taken at INTI College may be used to fulfill a specific OSU degree requirement, please remember that:
 - You should refer to the OSU catalog for a detailed description of the university policy regarding degree requirements.
 - Each college determines the general education requirements for its specific degree programs.
 - In general, if a course from INTI College has been evaluated as equal to an OSU course and that course number is found on the specific degree sheet, it is likely that the course will apply to that degree plan when the student enrolls at OSU.
 - In general, if a course from INTI College has been evaluated as equal to an OSU course and that course number is not found on the specific degree sheet, an advisor in the student's chosen major field will determine whether or not the specific course may be used to satisfy degree requirements.
 - In general, if a course from INTI College does not closely match a course offered at OSU and has been evaluated as an elective (----) credit, an advisor in the student's chosen major field will determine whether or not the specific course may be used to satisfy degree requirements.
 - When a course offered at INTI College satisfies both "S" and "H" general education requirements, the student's academic advisor will determine how the course will apply to the general education requirements of the OSU degree program. One course cannot satisfy both "S" and "H" general education requirements at OSU.
 - When a course satisfies a "S" or "H" general education requirement and it also carries an "I" designation, it will also satisfy the "I" general education requirement.
 - When a course satisfies an "N" general education requirement and it also carries an "L" designation, it will also satisfy the "L" general education requirement.
 - AMERICAN HISTORY: Completing HIS 251 or HIS 252 at INTI College, as a substitution will satisfy the American History (HIST 1103) general education requirement. A student does not need to complete both HIS 251 and HIS 252 since only 3 credit hours of American History are needed to fulfill the American History requirement.
 - ENGLISH: Completing ENL 101 and ENL 102 at INTI College, as a substitution will satisfy the English Composition (ENGL 1113 & ENGL 1213) general education requirements.
 - STATISTICS: Completing STA 219 at INTI College, as a substitution will satisfy degree program requirements when STAT 2023 is listed as a degree program requirement.
