INTRODUCTION

This Guide has been prepared for use by academic advisors and by students intending to transfer and complete their four-year degree at Oklahoma State University. **From your most recent course catalog available, we have chosen to identify each course that will transfer as an equivalent OSU course. Also included are courses that do not necessarily match a course at OSU but are honored for general education credit.** These unmatched courses will be displayed with a leading number indicating the level of the course, followed by three dashes to indicate that there has not been a matched course identified at OSU. Please note the paragraph below provides a more thorough explanation of this scenario. **Courses that are listed in your course catalog but have not been included in the OSU transfer guide will transfer as “electives” (credit hours but no specific course credit).** An advisor at OSU will determine whether or not such courses may be used to fulfill requirements in a specific major. We have also included a listing of helpful telephone numbers, and we encourage you to call OSU if you have questions relative to these specialty areas. We hope the attached list of majors will be helpful in considering the degree options available when attending OSU. A campus map is also included in our transfer guide to help locate specific sites should you choose to visit our campus.

According to University policy and with the approval of the dean from the appropriate OSU college, these courses may be substituted for required courses or may apply as elective credit. Courses which may be used to fulfill general education requirements are identified by code letters immediately preceding the course title. The code letters used are as follows:

A - Analytical and Quantitative Thought
H - Humanities
I - International Dimension
L - Scientific Investigation
N - Natural Science
S - Social and Behavioral Sciences
