TRANSFER CREDIT GUIDE TRANSLATION

The use of (----) in place of a course number reflects there is not an exact equivalent for this course. In cases where dashes (----) appear in place of an OSU departmental reference, an appropriate departmental reference is not available. According to University policy and with the approval of the dean from the appropriate OSU College, these courses may be substituted for required courses or may apply as elective credit. Courses which may be used to fulfill general education requirements (GED) are identified by code letters. The code letters used are as follows:

GENERAL EDUCATION (GED) CODES

A = Analytical and Quantitative Thought
H = Humanities
I = International Dimension
L = Scientific Investigation
N = Natural Science
S = Social and Behavioral Sciences

Courses that are listed in your course catalog but have not been included in the OSU transfer guide will transfer as “electives” (credit hours but no specific course equivalency). The following exceptions apply to the preceding statement.

- According to Regents policy, beginning with Spring 1995, Leisure activity courses and Athletic (varsity sports) courses will no longer be applied toward graduation requirements or be reflected in the grade percentage average (GPA).
- Also listed in this Guide are equivalent zero-level courses offered for remediation purposes. These courses are identified by a number beginning with zero. **All zero-level/remedial course credit will not count toward graduation requirements at OSU or be reflected in the grade percentage average (GPA).**
